his game is a good way to put target words into productive written use. It also focuses on words in context and grammatical accuracy.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Write all the students' names in the first column of the grid (see Appendix).
- 2. Write the target words along the top row.
- 3. Sit at the front of the room with the grid.
- 4. Students close all their vocabulary books and dictionaries.
- 5. Explain that everyone has to write his or her own perfect sentence using the words you give them.
- 6. Write the first word on the board so that all students can see it.
- 7. Students write a sentence using the word, then bring it up for you to check.
- 8. If the sentence is meaningful and grammatically correct, they get a tick on the grid and can start on the next word.
- 9. The first student to get a tick writes the next word on the board.
- 10. If the sentence is not perfect, do not mark it but send the student back to think about it and make it right.

- 11. Students cannot start on the next word until their first sentence is perfect.
- 12. The first student to get six ticks becomes the Vocab Champ.

CAVEATS AND OPTIONS

- 1. It is important that you do not correct wrong sentences. The idea is that students think about their sentences and correct them themselves.
- 2. This activity works well with a class of around 12 students. If there are many more, you can't check all the sentences quickly enough.
- 3. The Vocab Champ(s) can help other students with their sentences.
- 4. Adjust the difficulty level of this activity by including a grammar structure (e.g., word + past tense, word + passive, word + if).
