Objective

Form noun clauses from wh- questions

Step 1: Look at the question

Example: What is the capital of Australia?

Step 2: Respond with two sentences

- Each group should write 2 responses for each question.
 - 1: We know/ don't know + noun clause
 - 2: Your answer, as a FULL SENTENCE
- Example:
 - 1: We know what the capital of Australia is.
 - 2: The capital of Australia is Canberra.

Step 3: Get points

- When you are sure about your answers and everyone in your group agrees, all students in the group should raise their hands.
- Your teacher will call on only ONE person to answer the question.
- This person should read both sentences.
- Scoring: 2 points possible for each question
 - 1 for the correct sentence with a noun clause.
 - 1 for the correct answer to the trivia question in a full sentence.
- The team with the most points wins!
