## Installing Your Reader

**Step 1:** Find the installation file you downloaded and double click it. The screen below will display. Click on the "Next" button.

**Step 7:** To read an issue, hold your mouse over an issue and right click your mouse. A drop down window will appear. Hold your mouse over the "Open in new window" option and click your left mouse button once. This will open the issue in a new browser window.



**Step 8**: Your issue window will appear behind your *FeedReader* window. Simply click on the window and enjoy your issue.



#### Configuring Your FeedReader

**Step 1:** To configure your *FeedReader*, click on "Tools" and then "Properties."



**Step 2:** You may change any "General" setting, however the defaults work well.



**Step 3:** Click on "Appearance" and change the refresh to "Every 2 Hours." Then change "Visibility duration (sec)" to "2 Minutes." Make sure the option "Use notification box fade in and out" is checked. This will ensure that you are notified whenever an issue is sent. (You may want to periodically check your *FeedReade*r icon found in the system tray to ensure that you did not miss a notification.) Click "OK" when done.



**Step 4**: When a new issue is sent to your *FeedReader*, this message window will appear just above your system tray in the lower right hand corner of your screen.
