

## THE NUMBERS EXERCISE

In the following simple math problems, a “ $\times$ ” means to multiply. A “ $\div$ ” means to add. A “ $\div$ ” sign means to divide, and an “ $-$ ” means to subtract.

Complete these problems following the above instructions. Do not change the signs on the paper. Hold your hand up when you are finished. Hurry! This will be timed.

$$8 \times 2 =$$

$$9 \div 1 =$$

$$9 \div 11 =$$

$$20 \div 10 =$$

$$4 \times 3 =$$
